A family history since 1944



Located in the heart of the Muscadet Côtes de Grand Lieu appellation, the Haut Bourg estate is a family estate that has been passed down through four generations. Founded in 1944, the vineyard now covers 32 hectares.

Its red sandy soils, gravel and quartz pebbles, combined with a unique microclimate between Lake Grand Lieu, the Loire River and the Atlantic Ocean, produce balanced, rounded wines with subtle hints of iodine.



Modernity at the service of quality

Anchored in modernity, our estate has chosen to make significant investments in order to control every stage of its development.

From planting the vines to vinification and order preparation, the entire process is carried out in-house, without intermediaries.

This organisation allows us to be highly responsive, particularly in the management and dispatch of orders.

Complete control of the production chain also guarantees the safety and consistency of our wines.

Cold tartaric stabilisation and bottling using our own equipment ensure precision, consistency and traceability.

This technical requirement serves a simple objective: to offer reliable wines that are carefully controlled and faithful to their terroir.



2 domains grouped under 1 entity

Faced with market developments and growing climate challenges, we have made a bold decision: to convert part of the estate to organic farming. Despite frost, mildew and botrytis in recent years, 9 hectares have been converted to organic farming since 2020, reflecting a responsible, clear-sighted and committed approach.

Domaine du Haut Bourg

With its 23 hectares certified High Environmental Value Level 3, it remains our historic entity.

Its grape varieties allow us to offer a wide range of wines packaged in bottles or bag-in-box.



Domaine H&N CHOBLET

This new entity, covering approximately 9 hectares, has been **certified organic** since 2023.

This estate specialises in white grape varieties from the Nantes region: Melon B., Sauvignon and Grolleau Gris





In 1994, 19 municipalities around Lake Grand Lieu obtained recognition for the Côtes de Grandlieu appellation. Thanks to its unique microclimate and precise plot boundaries, this appellation guarantees high-quality wines that are typical of their terroir and rich in character.




Underground tanks

A distinctive feature of the Nantes vineyards

Underground tanks offer several advantages:

- Stable temperature (10-12°C),
- Optimal exchange with lees thanks to their parallelepiped shape,
- Natural protection against oxidation, reducing the need for sulphur.

Underground tanks, which have been used for generations, are economical, durable and protect the wine from oxygen, ensuring fresh, mineral and expressive wines.
